ORDINANCE 2024-O-27

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE FALL 2024 AMENDMENT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, AMENDING TEXT ON PAGE 5-3 TO REVISE THE MINOR AMENDMENTS – PROCEDURES TO REQUIRE APPROVAL OF A MINOR AMENDMENT BY PLAN COMMISSION AND COUNCIL, FULLY DESCRIBED BELOW.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 62.23(2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the City of Fitchburg, is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the City of Fitchburg Comprehensive Plan allows the City to process amendments no more frequently than twice per year, and

WHEREAS, the State Comprehensive Planning Law requires that the City follow the same administrative procedures for adoption defined under Wisconsin Statutes, Section 66.1001(4), to amend the Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the City of Fitchburg has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of Wisconsin Statutes, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(b) and (c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the City of Fitchburg Plan Commission, through adoption of Plan Commission Resolution PCR-08-24, has recommended the Council approve this amendment, and

WHEREAS, the City of Fitchburg Plan Commission has ensured the amendment is in full compliance with the Comprehensive Plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Fitchburg, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The City of Fitchburg, Wisconsin, does hereby adopt the Fall 2024 Comprehensive Plan Amendment, Amending Text on Page 5-3 to Revise the Minor Amendments – Procedures to require approval of a minor amendment by Plan Commission and Council, in full text to be described and read as follows:


“8. Following the public hearing, the Common Council votes to approve, deny, or amend and re-refer to the Plan Commission the ordinance adopting the proposed Comprehensive Plan Amendment as recommended by the Plan Commission. Approval requires majority vote of the entire Council. The Common Council may make technical, non-substantive changes to the recommended Plan Commission version of the amendment without re-referral to Plan Commission. A substantive change affects the use of land or makes a qualitative change in the Plan.”

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect, as defined in Wisconsin Statute Section 59.001(2m), of the Common Council and publication/posting as required by law.
