Rate class definitions:

Residential: Water service that is provided for residential or domestic purposes.

Non-Residential: Water service provided to businesses, churches, multi family units, schools and government

Irrigation: Second meter to measure water used for lawn sprinkling, or other outside uses

Meter Charges: Fixed charges for water & sewer meters whether any volume is used or not

Water & Sewer Volume: Charges based on usage as measured by the water meter

Private Fire Protection: Connection to the water main for fire protection services such as automatic sprinkler systems and private hydrants

Public Fire Protection: Hydrants for fire protection service only and such quantities of may be demanded for the purpose of extinguishing fires

Stormwater: Based on impervious area where rain runs off rather than penetrating the ground

Water Ordinance Sec. 40-394

Water losses that occur on the premises, which are registered by the water meter, shall be the responsibility of the customer. It is the sole responsibility of the customer to prevent leakage in all piping and fixtures on the premises at and beyond the metering point, and that any leaks or losses of water, registered by the meter will be billed at the filed rates.
